


Dealing with illness and cold symptoms in children in nurseries and day-care centres

Information for parents and teaching practice

When must your child stay at home?





In the case of a **cold** without further signs of illness, observe at home for 24 hours. If no further symptoms occur, then the child can be looked after again.

Children with **chronic** illnesses (e.g. asthma, allergies, hay fever, neurodermatitis) can be looked after if they have no other or new symptoms.



Does your child need to see a doctor?

If yes, please contact your GP and/or paediatrician,



The doctor will decide whether to do a corona virus test

Please note that your child must not attend the establishment between taking the test and the determination of the result.

Your child is healthy again (fever free and fit)



The local health authority will decide on how to proceed, and the return to childcare.

The child can attend the relevant establishment again. A medical certificate is not necessary.
